Restoration Work continues on schedule at the Mansion. Lots of progress with the restoration has been made since the last update in the Dec-Jan newsletter. Some of the major items include: replacement of six rear porch post with new Alaskan Yellow Cedar posts, restoration of the remaining posts that were sound enough to remain, replacement of the 8"x8" wooden sills the posts rest on with air dried sassafras timbers, restoration of the trim and woodwork on the upper cornice, removal of the original wood trim elements that have been chemically stripped of lead paint and the re-installation of 70% of that material, restoration of the windows on the south façade as well as two sashes on the west facing façade, all windows have been returned to operating condition by restoring the rope and counter balance weight system, a cracked and broken glass has been replaced with wavy leaded glass reclaimed from old salvaged window sashes, wood shutters had to be fabricated and are nearing completion, the original hinges have been stripped of layers of paint and will be re-installed, new red cedar decking has replaced the old decking on the rear porch, the fascia and overhang of the rear porch has been restored and new handrails and balusters are currently in the installation process on the rear porch. This list is a highlights list, so it's easy to see that the restoration work is truly bringing the Mansion back to its original condition. Phase two of the work is scheduled to begin on the front façade of the building in mid March.

**Two Hearts Craft and Antique Show** – This was the first of several Friends sponsored events that will be held at the Mansion in 2012. The dates for this event were Friday – Sunday, February 3-4-5 and the response was great. Vendors were set up in all the lower level and in a portion of the second level. This was a free event for Friends members but there was a door charge for non-members. We were fortunate to have good pre-event coverage on TV and in the print media which helped greatly to generate a good attendance. This event will most likely be repeated next year with the addition of appraisal opportunities included.


